### TeenZones

A safe space where teens between 12 and 17 years of age can get together and participate in sports, artistic, and cultural activities, all supervised by dynamic leaders.

### Alternative Suspension

Drop-out prevention program that offers support to students who have been suspended from school or are at risk of suspension.

### Plusone Mentoring

Program that offers 10- to 17-year-olds who are experiencing social or academic difficulties the opportunity to participate in activities of their choice with a committed mentor.

### Pivot

Program that helps youth build positive relationships with their community by promoting healthy relationships and access to community programs and services, and broadening their support network.

### Diversion

Program that offers youth between 12 and 17 years of age who are experiencing social difficulties, particularly because of a severe deficiency, the opportunity to be active, learn, socialize, build their self-esteem, and become more independent.

### Toxico

An academic perseverance program offering addiction prevention services in high schools and support to young people with addiction problems.

### Succession

Program that offers young adults (18 to 35 years of age) experiencing social difficulties, particularly because of a severe deficiency, the opportunity to participate in workshops and activities, socialize, define who they are, and build their self-esteem.

### Équijustice Montréal (West)

Organization that offers restorative justice services for teenagers and adults who committed an offence, support services for victims, and community mediation services.

### Club 60 +

Activities for seniors so they can stay active, socialize, and add variety to their daily routine.
